
## Sequencing

Putting instructions in the right order is called sequencing. It is an important part of algorithmic thinking and programming.

## Schatch Puzzle solution

This Scratch program is supposed to show the lifecycle of a frog. It does this by changing the costume (picture) of the frog. Starting from frogspawn, it switches to the costume of each stage in turn. Once it gets to the last instruction, it starts again so it repeats the lifecycle forever.

However, the costumes are all mixed up. Put them in the right order in the program.
